Application of the NCP and IDNT: Enhancing the

Value of Your Work in Public Health/Community Nutrition

AODA member Camella Rising, MS, RD, LDN and Marcy Fenton, MS, RD, are conducting an upcoming webinar entitled "Application of the NCP and IDNT: Enhancing the Value of Your Work in Public Health/Community Nutrition". The use of the Nutrition Care Process (NCP) and International Dietetics and Nutrition Terminology (IDNT, also known as "standardized language") in the area of public health/community nutrition could help scale up nutrition interventions globally and also bring together the different nutrition practice areas for continuity of patient/client care.

Following this webinar, clinicians should be able to:

- Identify with specific examples how the NCP and IDNT can be applied to public health/community nutrition practice, including work with individuals and populations.
- Describe how the NCP and IDNT aligns with diverse work streams, such as planning and implementing programs, developing policies, and using performance/quality improvement measures.
- Name several reasons why full implementation of the NCP and IDNT are critical to protecting the role of nutrition services and registered dietitians in the context of a changing health care environment.
