The premise is that the AODA member and colleague will have somewhat different knowledge and skill sets that, when brought together, will serve to fulfill a special project.

Award amount: \$3,000

First International Nutritionist/Dietitian (FIND) Fellowship for Study in the USA

This award is given to assist foreign nationals who are pursuing postgraduate work in the USA and have a clearly articulated plan to return to their country.

Award amount: \$2,000

Wimpfheimer-Guggenheim Fund for International Exchange in Nutrition, Dietetics and Management

This award is given to provide for the international exchange of needed nutrition, dietetic and/or management information for the benefit of the nutritional health of the world community. Up to two awards may be given.

Award amount: \$1,100

Food and Research Action Center (FRAC) and Children's Healthwatch: Food Insecurity & Hunger in the US

The 4th issue of [Food Insecurity and Hunger in the US: New Research](#) has been issued by the Food Research and Action Center (FRAC) and Children's Healthwatch.

The New Research section highlights 9 recent studies related to food insecurity, including several large studies and literature reviews on food insecurity in the US, as well as studies on food insecurity in childhood and pregnancy.

FDA to Hold Public Meeting on Updates to the Redbook

The US Food and Drug Administration will hold an [open meeting on December 9, 2014](#) to receive input from the public on updating the Guidance for Industry "Toxicological Principles for the Safety Assessment of Food Ingredients," also known as the "Redbook."

The FDA encourages members of industry, academia, and the public to provide ideas and opinions on what should be included, changed, or even removed from the current Redbook. The agency is also considering expanding the scope of the Redbook to include chemical safety assessments for all areas over which the CFSAN has statutory authority (e.g. food additives, food contact substances, dietary supplement ingredients, food contaminants, and cosmetics).

The meeting will take place at the Harvey H. Wiley Federal Building, 5100 Paint Branch Parkway, College Park, Md., from 9:00 am - 5:00 pm.

It argues that family farms must be supported to innovate in ways that promote sustainable intensification of production and improvements in rural livelihoods.

2015 John Milner Nutrition and Cancer Prevention Research Practicum

The 2015 John Milner Nutrition and Cancer Prevention Research Practicum will take place **March 2 to 6**, and is now accepting applications - application deadline is **December 19, 2014**. The Practicum will be held at the National Cancer Institute in Rockville, Maryland, the NIH Clinical Center and the USDA Beltsville Human Nutrition Center. This week-long educational offering provides specialized instruction about the role of diet and bioactive food components as modifiers of cancer incidence and tumor behavior. The intent of the Practicum is to introduce participants to research currently being conducted in the field, expose them to available research opportunities, and lay the foundation for future researchers in diet and cancer prevention.
